IMMACULATE MARY

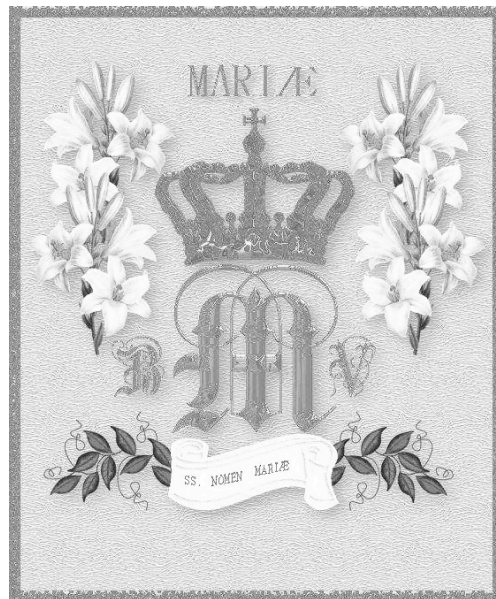
**Immaculate Mary! Our hearts are on fire;
