CLOSING OF TRIDUUM TO ST. ANNE

Priest & People: Hail, thou full of grace,/ the Lord is with thee;/ let thy grace be with me!/ Blessed art thou amongst women,/ and blessed be thy mother Anne,/ who brought thee forth,/ O Virgin Mary/ all Immaculate/ and of thee was born/ Jesus Christ,/ the Son of the Living God./ Amen. *(Three times)*
(Pope Alexander VI granted an indulgence of twenty years to all who should devoutly repeat this prayer three times before an image of St. Anne.)

ANTIPHON

Priest: Rejoice, blessed Anne, dear to the Lord, thou who didst give birth to her who brought God the Saviour into the world. Worthy of all honor art thou, who didst bear that noble Virgin Mary, the human mother of the God-Man. Most holy Anne, thy daughter gave suck to the Son of the Most High; blessed Anne, of thy flesh was born the Mother of the Lord, the glory of virgins, the comfort of those in distress. To thee we make our prayer; take pity on us, that we may rejoice for all eternity in the presence of God. Alleluia.

Priest: Rejoice and be glad, blessed Anna

People: Thy child is the Mother of Our Lord.

Priest: Let us pray. God, Who wast pleased to bestow such grace upon blessed Anne that she became worthy to bear in her womb thy blessed Mother Mary, at the intercession of them both, grant us thy abundant mercy, so that by the prayers of the mother and daughter whose memory we thus devoutly cherish, we may come to the heavenly Jerusalem. Who livest and reignest forever and ever. **R. Amen.**
